Clinical Services Building

Adult accessible change room

Changing Places are accessible adult change facilities to allow individuals with high support needs to take part in all elements of community life, without having to limit their time out due to concerns about access to a suitable toilet and change room.

Changing Places provide suitable, safe and dignified facilities for people who are not accommodated by standard accessible toilets. Changing Places is located in the ground floor lobby of the Clinical Services Building.

These facilities are larger than standard accessible toilets and have extra features and more space to meet the requirements of people with specialised care needs and their carers.

Some key features include:

- Height-adjustable adult-sized change table, with side safety rail
- Integrated motorised ceiling lifter*
- Automatic sliding door with clear opening of 950mm
- Retractable privacy screen to provide dignity whilst using the toilet
- Toilet with backrest and drop-down grab rails
- Long horizontal changing/grab rails on the wall set at different heights.

*Please note: A sling is not provided; individuals will need to bring their own sling to be able to use the ceiling lifter.
