

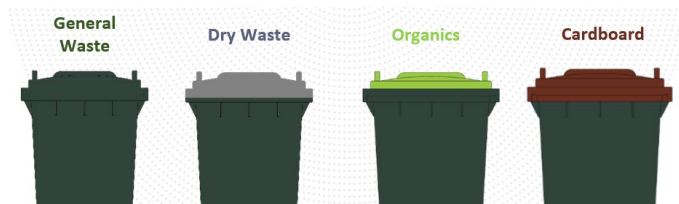

Waste management service

Clinical Services Building

Waste management services at TQEH are provided by ISS Facility Services. This includes managing the safe collection, segregation, handling, transport, and disposal of waste around the hospital and from the site.

The correct mobile waste bins will be made available in disposal rooms, dirty utility or other designated spaces such as confidential bins in staff hubs.



All mobile waste bins containing clinical, chemical, cytotoxic, and hazardous waste are removed from the site by a specialist, licensed waste management contractor ensuring the safe disposal in accordance with the *Environmental Protection Act 1993* and relevant health policies.

Staff rooms and Beverage bays

Staff rooms and beverage bays have pull-out bins within the joinery that support organic and general waste segregation. Please use the appropriate bin to support the reduction in environmental impact.

Under-desk bins

There will be no under-desk waste bins provided or available in the new building. Staff who would like to keep an under-desk bin will be responsible for supplying the bin and emptying waste into the correct centralised bins as the ISS cleaning contractors will no longer be emptying under-desk bins. This initiative supports staff to get up and move and is consistent with practices at other CALHN sites.

Sanitary disposal bins

Each female and all-gender toilet cubicle will be equipped with a sanitary disposal unit which will be managed and maintained by ISS. This supports the diverse needs of everyone and fosters an inclusive environment.
